SUBJECT: Formal demand: Compliance with preliminary injunctions dated May 15 and immediate restitution of property under notice of criminal action.

Dear Sirs,

We are writing to you in relation to the court order (*Auto*) dated May 15 regarding preliminary injunctions, whereby you were bindingly ordered to immediately cease all works on the swimming pool and in the pool area.

Furthermore, we inform you that our legal representation has filed a motion this week before the competent court, requesting that you be immediately ordered to proceed with the filling of the swimming pool and the reinstallation of the tiles. We hereby formally demand that you communicate to us as soon as possible the binding deadline planned for the execution of these actions.

In addition, we demand that you restore the entirety of the sun loungers unlawfully removed by you from the pool area (both the loungers with grey fabric covers and the white plastic loungers) no later than next Tuesday, May 26, 2026, at 4:00 PM, on the lower solarium. This area will be used by the owners as a terrace/solarium until the definitive commissioning of the swimming pool.

Should you fail to return our property within the strict deadline indicated above, we will proceed, without further notice or delay, to file the corresponding criminal complaint for the crime of theft or misappropriation (*apropiación indebida*) against you.
